## CABOOLTURE SHOW FARRIERS COMPETITION

SUNDAY 9th JUNE, 2019

### CONDITIONS:

- Competition to be run in accordance with Australian Farriers' and Blacksmiths' Association Competition Rules and By-Laws
- Proof of payment must accompany entry. An entry that isn't accompanied by a cheque or a copy/screenshot of bank transfer will be considered invalid and will not be processed.
- Competitors must be members of PFBAQ or AFBA affiliated member.
- **Safety glasses** must be worn by **all competitors** and **horse holders** while in competition arena. It is the competitor's responsibility to bring safety glasses to the competition.
- Competitors are to organize their own horse holders.

**Class 1: Ross Chicken Open Shoeing/Forging:** Shoe 1 foot with a  $\frac{3}{4}$  Fullered hammer drawn toe clip plus make a French Hind out of 25mm x 8mm flat steel, 135 mm wide x 145mm long, 6 nail holes to suit a MX50 nail, as per blueprint. Fireman allowed.

Time: 60 mins

**Class 2: Apprentice Shoeing/Forging:** Shoe 1 foot with one of the packet shoes provided plus make a  $\frac{3}{4}$  Fullered Hind out of 20mm x 10mm flat, 125mm wide x 140mm long, 6 nail holes to suit an E4 Slim nail, as per blueprint. Fireman allowed (fireman allowed to go to foot to advise on trimming shoe fit etc. but cannot touch the foot).

Time: 65 mins

**Class 3: Master & Apprentice Class:** Master and Apprentice can enter as a team or Apprentices can enter individually and will be paired up at random with a Qualified Farrier competing. Drawn teams will be notified 1 week prior to contest. Shoe 1 foot with a  $\frac{3}{4}$  fullered toe clip shoe and make a Scotch Heel Draft Front plain stamped out of 32mm x 12mm flat, 210mm wide x 190mm long, 8 nail holes to suit an E10 nail. Specimen Shoe provided on the day.

Time: 60 mins

**Class 4: Open Judges Choice:** Make shoe to Judges Specimen shown on the day.

Time: 20mins

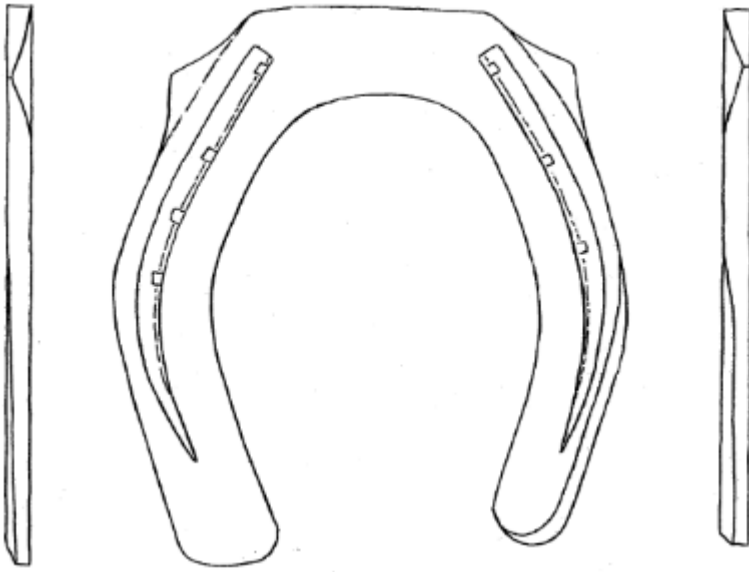
**Class 5: Apprentice Judges Choice:** Make a shoe to Judge's Specimen shown on the day.

Time: 20 mins

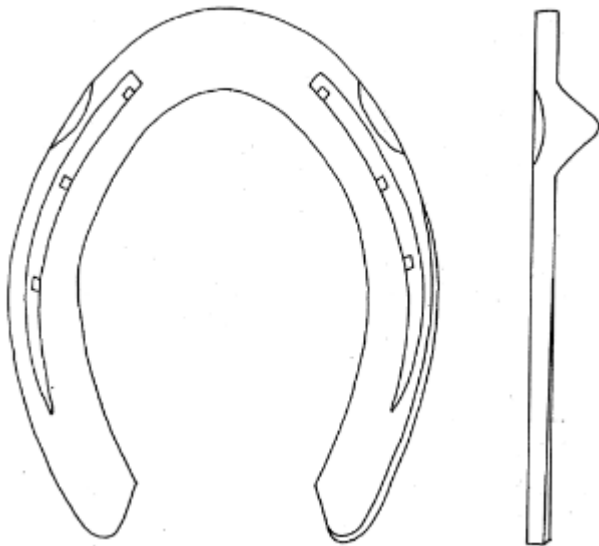
**Class 6: Tong Class:** Make a pair of fire tongs any style to hold any type of steel. Steel to be submitted with tongs.

## Release and Waiver of Liability Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this activity.

I/We confirm the Recreational Service Supplier has explained this document to me/us and I/we am/are aware of the implications, intent and effect of agreeing to signing the document. I/We furthermore confirm I/we am/are aware of the obvious risks associated with activities involving horses and I/we knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the Recreational Service Supplier (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse related activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this activity.

I agree to follow the directions given to me and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction can result in the **CANCELLATION** of participation in the activity and my immediate removal from any horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AND AGREE NOT TO SUE the Recreational Service Supplier, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, OR loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
