Event 1: Novice Blacksmithing

Make a coat and hat hook as per blueprint.

Criteria: Forging -10, Adherence to Blueprint - 10, Finish – 10. Time: 40 minutes.

Time: 40 minutes

Event 2: Intermediate Blacksmithing

Make a split link.

Criteria: Dimensions – 10, Forging – 10, Adherence to blueprint– 10, Finish – 10.

Time: 45 minutes.

Event 3: Open Blacksmithing

Make a pair of Gooseneck tongs, for holding 20mm x 10 mm barstock, 500 mm long. Criteria: Forging -10, Dimensions -10, Welding - 10, Form to Function -10, Quality of Rivet – 5, Finish -10.

Time: 50 minutes

Event 4: 4 Man Draft

Teams consisting of 4 members will work together to shoe a draft horse. Each team member must complete one foot: trim foot, forge shoe, nail shoe on and finish foot. Team members may work simultaneously or in relay. Striking, hot rasping allowed. Horse handler must be a team member.

Specs: $\frac{3}{4}$ fullered flat shoe, toe clip front and hind to be hammer drawn, shoes to have definite inside and outside branches, 8 nail holes.

Barstock: 32mm x 12mm flat

Judging: Will be individual and team.

Event 5: Novice/Intermediate Shoeing

1. Shoe one hoof, 20mm x 10mm flat bar stock, plain stamped shoe, 6 nail holes, nails to suit. Toe clip (bob punched or hammer drawn).

2. Specimen shoe: Make a fullered hind shoe out of 20mm x 10mm flat stock, 130mm wide x 140mm long, three quarter fullered. Quarter clips, 6 nail holes, clips can be bob punched or hammer drawn. 6 nail holes to suit E4 slim. As per blueprint. Hot rasping, fireman allowed. No Striker.

Time: 60 minutes

Event 6: Open Shoeing

1. Shoe one hoof, $\frac{3}{4}$ fullered, 20mm x 10mm flat bar stock. 6 nail hoes, nails to suit, toe clip.
2. Specimen Shoe: Make an aluminium heart bar of 25mm x 12mm bar stock – 145mm wide x 145mm long. Side clips, 8 nail holes to suit E5 slim nails. As per blueprint.
Time: 60 minutes

Event 7: 2 Man Forging – Swap over at 30 minutes.

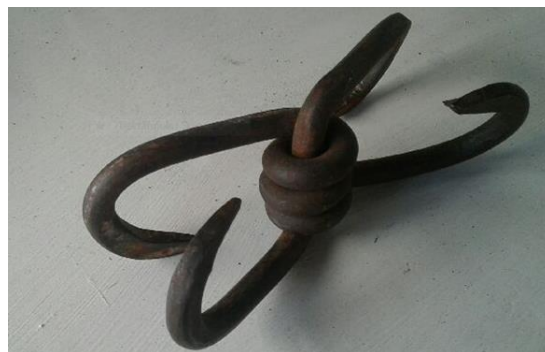
1. Make a tool and fullered front shoe out of 16mm square stock, 130mm wide x 125mm long, toe clip, fully fullered, 6 nail holes to suit Concave 4.
2. Make a lateral extension front shoe out of 25mm x 8mm flat bar. 125mm wide x 125mm long. Masselot clip, $\frac{3}{4}$ fullered, 6 nail holes to suit E3 slim nails. As per blueprint.
Hot rasping allowed. Fireman allowed. No striker.

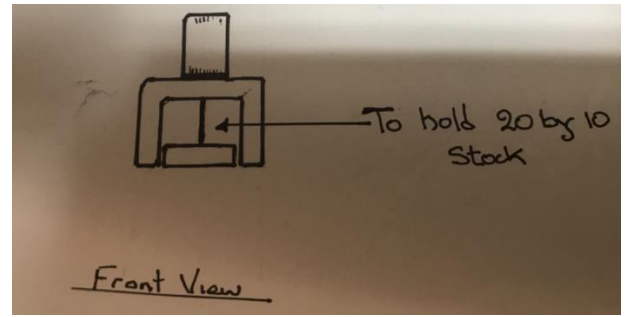
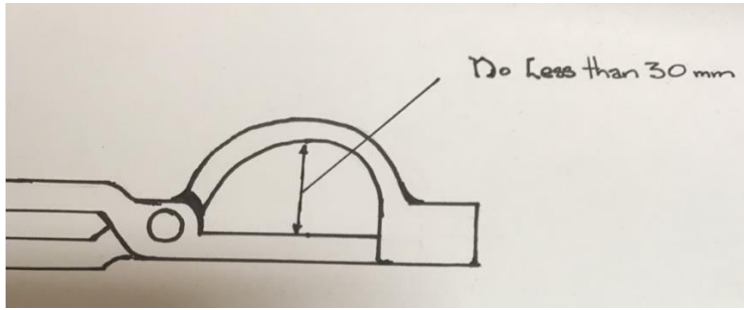
Event 1 Novice Blacksmithing



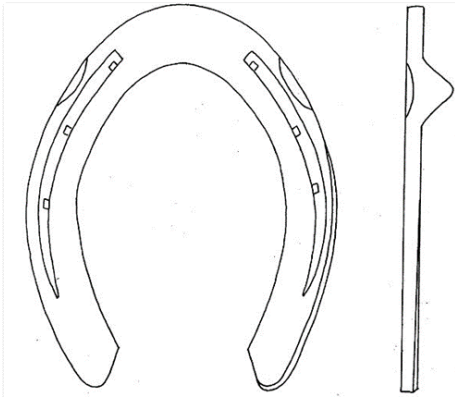
Event 2: Intermediate Blacksmithing



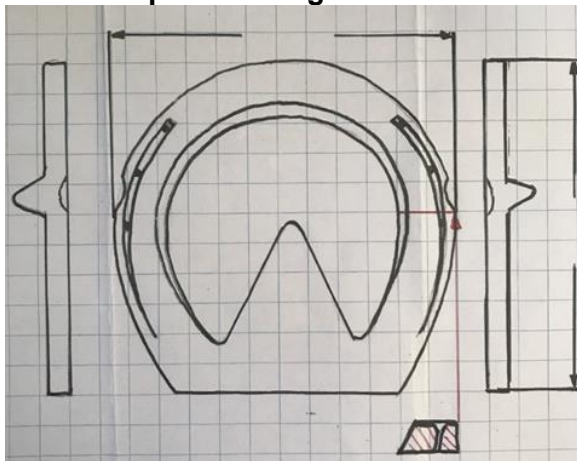
Event 3: Open Blacksmithing

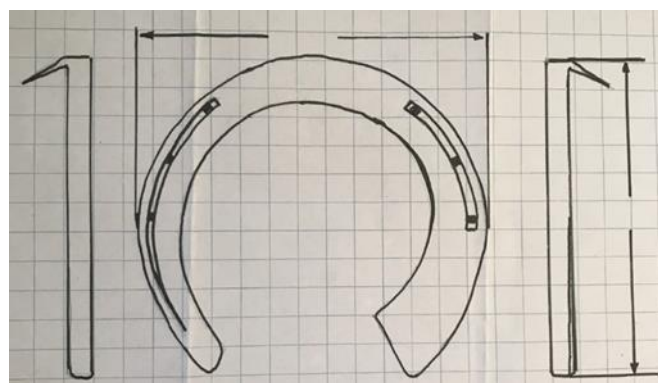

Release and Waiver of Liability Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

Supplier of recreational service:

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this activity.

I/We confirm the Recreational Service Supplier has explained this document to me/us and I/we am/are aware of the implications, intent and effect of agreeing to signing the document. I/We furthermore confirm I/we am/are aware of the obvious risks associated with activities involving horses and I/we knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the Recreational Service Supplier (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my **OWN RISK** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse related activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this activity.

I agree to follow the directions given to me and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction can result in the **CANCELLATION** of participation in the activity and my immediate removal from any horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AND AGREE NOT TO SUE the Recreational Service Supplier, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, OR loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
