Saturday, 4th May

Event 1: Shoe near side front foot with a front beveled shoe plain stamped, out of 32mm x 12mm steel, nails E10. Rasping allowed.
Specimen: Make a front shoe, with a slight bevel to edges, and a thickened outside heel out of 32mm x 12mm steel, 205 mm wide and 190 mm long, 85 mm between heels, E10 Nail. No rasping, hammer finish only. As per specimen.
Time: 70 minutes.

Event 2: Shoe near side hind foot with a hind beveled shoe, plain stamped, out of 32mm x 12mm steel, nails E10. Rasping allowed.
Specimen: Make a deep seated fullered hind straight bar, quarter clipped, out of 32mm x 12mm, 193 mm wide and 192 mm long (diagonal outside heel to toe centre), bar corner to corner 115mm wide, E10 Nail. No rasping, hammer finish only. As per specimen.
Time: 70 minutes

Sunday, 5th May

Event 3: Shoe off side front foot with a front beveled shoe plain stamped, out of 32mm x 12mm steel, nails E10. Rasping allowed.
Specimen: Make a toe clipped caulk and feather, out of 32mm x 12mm, 190 mm wide and 190 mm long (to inside diagonal toe centre) 97 mm between heels on foot surface, E10 Nail. No rasping, hammer finish only. As per specimen.
Time: 70 minutes

Event 4: 1. Shoe off side hind foot with a hind beveled shoe, plain stamped, out of 32mm x 12mm steel, nails E10. Rasping allowed.
2. Judges Choice
Time: 90 minutes

Event 5: Make a winker bit at any time throughout the competition. Steel to be provided at the beginning of the competition.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- **All specimen shoes hammer drawn clips. Foot shoes any style.**
- The competition will be run over two days and is for three-man teams.
- Teams can be made up from individuals from any State of Country. Individual entries accepted.
- Trophies for 1st to 3rd place. Prizemoney 1st to 5th place (depending on entries)
- Draw will be emailed out one week prior to commencement of event.
- ***QLD competitors must be P.F.B.A.Q members to compete.***
- ***Interstate competitors must complete AON indemnity form and pay \$20 weekend membership for insurance purposes.***
- **Closing date for entries: 12th April, 2019.**

COMPETITION RULES:

The following are rules for the duration of the competition. Clarification of these rules should be sought prior to commencement of the competition. Failure to comply with competition rules may result in disqualification.

1. The competition is a team event comprising three people (fireman/striker, shoemaker and floor person).
2. Each member is permitted to perform any of the above tasks.
3. Only one hoof to be worked on at any one time.
4. The team can be made up of competitors from any country, state or territory and must remain as a team throughout the competition.
5. Any involvement of non-team members during the competition is not permitted.
6. Competitors are to supply and be responsible for their own hand tools.
7. Time limits will be **strictly adhered to**. On competition of time allowed, the shoes must be placed on the anvil and all work on the horse shall cease.
8. Event must be completed to score.
9. Competitors shall not enter another team's work area.
10. If in the event of equipment breakdown, the competitor is to signal the steward. Time will then be stopped for that team and restarted again when the problem has resolved. (This does not include hand tools).
11. Any technique seen to be detrimental to the horse's well-being will not be permitted as determined by judging officials.
12. **Anybody inside the competition arena or cut-off saw area must wear safety glasses. This is compulsory. No excuses will be accepted.** It is the competitor's responsibility to bring safety glasses to the competition.
13. **Competitors are to organize their own horse holders for the competition.**
14. Non-competitors are not to enter the competition area unless instructed by a steward.
15. Hot rasping will be allowed unless otherwise stated.
16. Swaging tools are not permitted.
17. Flatters are permitted (a flatter is described as any tool with a flat working surface that is used between the hammer and the object being worked).
18. Bevel shoes follow the extension contour of the foot.
19. Competitors may do a rough cut if they have a horse with an excessively long foot after conferring with a steward and doing the rough cut in the presence of the steward.
20. Feet – sandpaper allowed.
21. No foreign substances allowed on foot or shoe.
22. The judge's decision is final.
23. Anyone found under the influence of alcohol prior to competing will be disqualified.
24. A Disputes Committee will be formed and shall consist of three elected non-competing members of the P.F.B.A.Q. Competitors submitting an objection must do so in writing no later than one (1) hour after the event in which the alleged offence took place. Failure to do so will result in the objection being dismissed. A \$50.0 deposit must accompany the written objection, this deposit will be returned to the competitor should the objection be sustained by the Disputes Committee

Release and Waiver of Liability Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

Supplier of recreational service:

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this activity.

I/We confirm the Recreational Service Supplier has explained this document to me/us and I/we am/are aware of the implications, intent and effect of agreeing to signing the document. I/We furthermore confirm I/we am/are aware of the obvious risks associated with activities involving horses and I/we knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the Recreational Service Supplier (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I voluntarily **PARTICIPATE** at my **OWN RISK** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse related activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this activity.

I agree to follow the directions given to me and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction can result in the **CANCELLATION** of participation in the activity and my immediate removal from any horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AND AGREE NOT TO SUE the Recreational Service Supplier, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, OR loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
